Our first trip of the year went out this week with Year 10 students travelling to London to see Matilda. I would like to thank all the staff that both went on the trip and took on additional cover lessons to make this a reality.

We have also started our 'Showcase' weeks. These are a series of reviews, inviting external professionals to assess our work and the progress the school has made. The first Showcase was completed for our RAISE and SEND departments, feedback was very positive, and recognised the hard work done by both teams.

As the weather starts to change, I would also like to remind parents about the wet weather protocols we need to run to maintain a safe site.

At break students currently have free access to the building, and we ask that they move about calmy and considerate of the limited space we have available. They do this exceptionally well, and this has allowed us to keep this provision in place. Previously, students had to remain in their period 2 classroom during a wet break.

At lunch time we have to run a split lunch. Years 7 and 11 have first lunch in the canteen. Years 8, 9 and 10 go to their form room. For session two, Years 7 and 11 are in form rooms and Years 8 and 9 are in the canteen. Year 10 are in the main hall.

This allows us to maintain a safe site while giving as much social time as we can to students.
