We are proud beyond measure of you all, Lets go and show them what we've got!

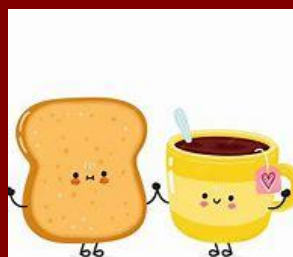
Collapsed Timetable - Week 1 (WB 5.5.25)
