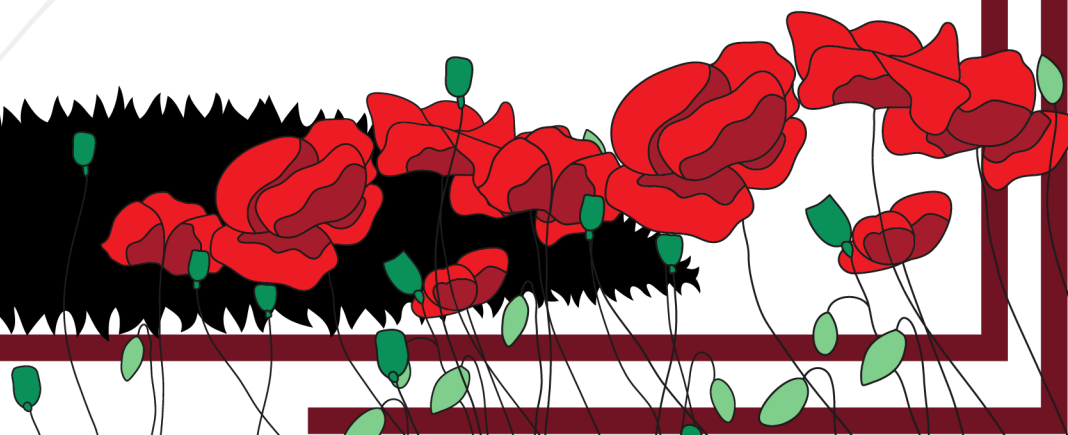
Remembrance Services
