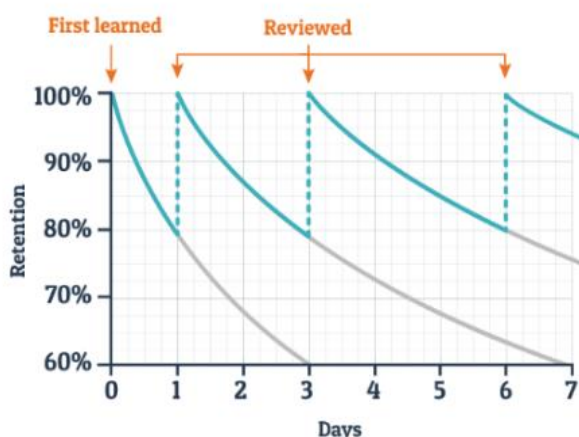

Typical Forgetting Curve for Newly Learned Information

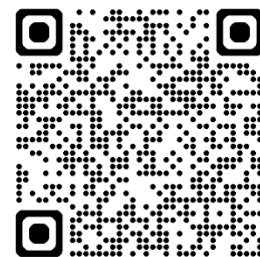
