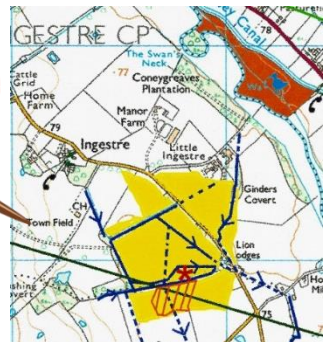


Ingestre Hall Residential Arts Trip 2022

Other students were able to focus on Dance or Drama according to their interest.



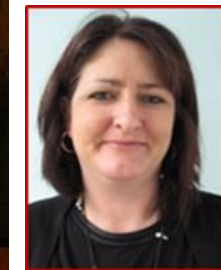
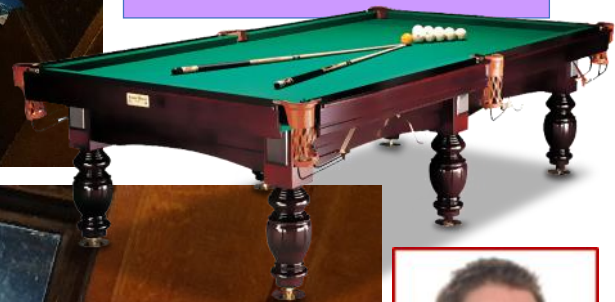


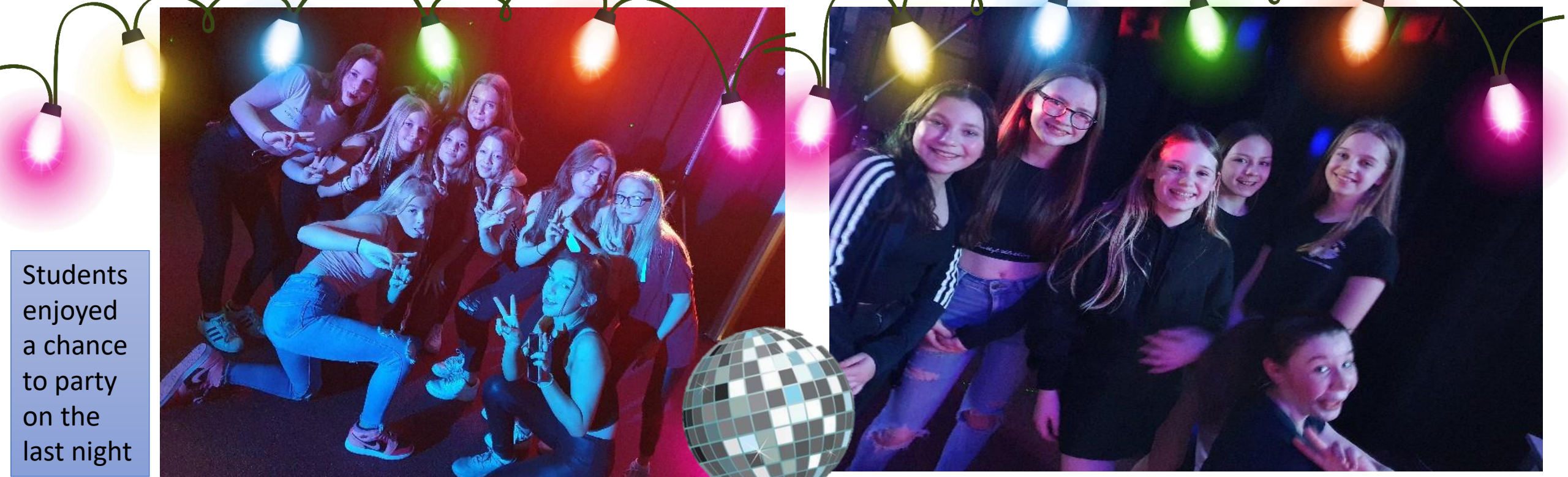
Students really enjoyed the social aspect of the residential and were able to participate in a host of activities from table tennis and table football to board games, a night time treasure hunt to just chilling with their friends
